
How to Edit the Preheader Text in an Email Preview




The preheader text is the text that is displayed under the subject line in an email preview, as seen at left.

To Edit the Preheader Text

1. Open the email you are editing, making sure it is in its own window.

2. Select "Edit HTML" under the PoliteMail Tab



3. Use the ctrl + F keyboard shortcut to prompt the Find and Replace window and search for<body
