# How to Use Message Tagging

#### Message Tagging

Message Tagging is primarily used to sort and organize message results. You can then get metrics for messages sorted by Message Tagging. You can search and filter by a tag, and you can be automatically reminded to tag messages before sending.

#### Tagging versus Campaigns

Tags	Campaigns
Multiple tags can be assigned to a message	Multiple messages are assigned to a Campaign
Message tags can be Required	User must remember to assign message to a Campaign
Metrics available only per message	Campaign metrics available

## Creating Tags and Tag Groups

Tag Groups allow a user to select from a group of possible tags. For example, a "Departments" Tab Group could be created with possible tags of HR, IT, Sales, Operations, Legal, etc.

Only PoliteMail Admins have the ability to create Tag Groups and assign tags to them.

- Go to PoliteMail > Account > Tag Groups
- 2. Click **New** (**Add Group** in **v 4.9+**) to name a new group. A window appears.
- 3. Enter the name of the new group.
- 4. You can set this Group to Required, Predefined, neither, or both:
  - Required: The user must assign a tag before sending, and will receive a prompt before the message is sent to assign Tags to the email. They can choose from the list of Tags in the Group, or enter their own. If they enter their own, it is automatically added to the Tab Group.

Create custom tag groups that can be used by other PoliteMail users. You may set a tag group to 'Required', forcing all outgoing Pol

input while forcing users to select a tag from a list that you create. Setting a 'Caption' will determine what the user sees as text when

- Predefined: If the user tags the message, they must select from the Tags assigned to the Group and cannot enter their own.
- **Required and Predefined:** The user is required to select a Tag, and must select from the Tags assigned to the Group.
- **Nothing Checked:** The user may choose to not use any Tags, may choose a Tag from the Group, or may enter their own.
- 5. Entering a Caption will determine what text will appear in the dialogue window when prompted to set a tag for that message.
- 6. Add tags to be associated with this group in the Tags box.
  - In version 4.9x, you must click 'Create Group' first. Once your Group is created, click on it to select
    it. You'll now be presented with a window where you can add your tags. Click on Add New Record
    to add tags associated with this group. Once you've added the tag, click Update.
- 7. Click **Save** when finished.

#### **Deleting Tags**

**Version 5.0:** To delete any tags, hit the **X** icon next to the tag you wish to delete. To delete an entire Group, select the group and click the **Delete** icon.

**Version 4.9x:** To delete any tags, hit the trashcan icon next to the tag you wish to delete. To delete an entire Group, click the Tag icon with the red X.

#### **Editing Tags**

**Version 5.0:** Select the Group and click to open the popup window. From here, you can edit the Required and Predefined boxes, edit the caption, or change the name of the Group. Click **Save** when you are finished.

**Version 4.9x:** Click the **white pencil icon**. From here, you can edit the Required and Predefined boxes, edit the caption, or change the name of the Group. Click **Update Tag Group** when you are finished.

#### Adding Tags to Messages

Tags can only be added to measured (tracked) messages and you must have a Tag Group created. You can choose tags either before or after composing your message.

Click on the **Tag Message** icon. From here you can select which tags you want associated with the message.

You can have a single message be assigned to multiple Tag Groups, however, only one tag can be applied to each Tag Group. For example, the Admin has set up a Business Tag Group where the managers are listed. A user can tag a specific name in the Business Tag Group, while also tagging the Southwest Sales Region in the Sales Group.

### **Searching Tags**

#### Go to PoliteMail > Results > Messages

Search By Tag

Enter a tag to search.

OK

From the Actions menu choose Search by Tag.

Type in your search parameter and all messages with that associated tag will be listed. The Admin user could then view the metrics for these tagged messages, or export the tagged messages.

Admin users can also edit tags on messages already sent. Highlight the message you want to edit. Click on it to open the popup window. You can now choose which tag you want to change. In this example, the Admin is changing the tag from Pacific Region to Southeast Sales Region.
