PoliteMail places a cookie on the recipient's device that is used to open a tracked email. For example, if the Device that was used to open a tracked email was an iPad, a cookie is placed on the iPad enabling PoliteMail to track the number of devices per recipient. In otherwords, the number of iPads that were used to open the email.
