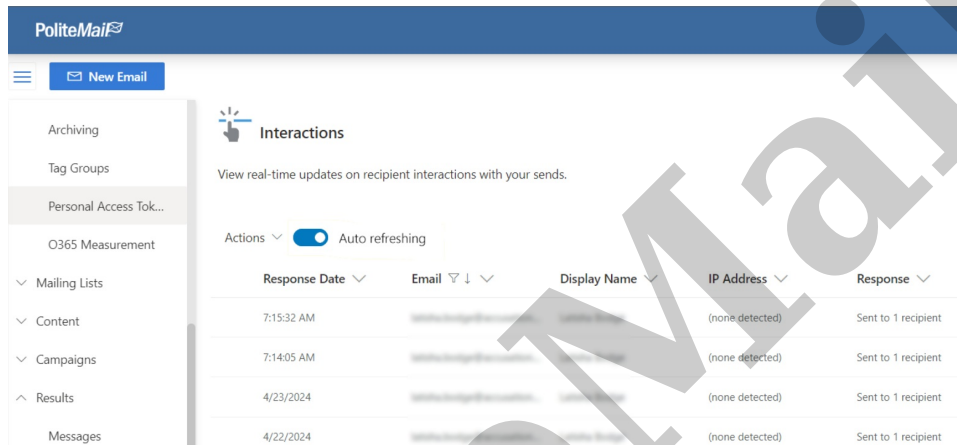


What does the Auto Refresh toggle do?
