
# Using Microsoft Stream with PoliteMail

## Uploading a Video to Microsoft Stream

From the Microsoft Stream home page, click on the upload button in the right-hand corner of the header. There is also an option to upload a video on the final page of the homepage carousel.



After choosing your video, you will be presented with a Details dialog box where you can enter in the video's name, description, and language. You can use one of the thumbnails Stream has provided, or upload your own.

## Using Microsoft Stream with PoliteMail

#### Create a Thumbnail

To begin, you'll want to create a thumbnail to embed in your PoliteMail message as a measured (tracked) link.

If you want to use one of thumbnails
 Microsoft Stream has selected, hover
 your mouse over it without selecting it.
 Right-click on it, choose Save As Picture,
 and download it. Or, you could use your
 own thumbnail.



#### Get the URL

Next, copy the video's address. By clicking on the Share icon, you'll get the link to the video.



### **Compose Your Message**

- 1. Open PoliteMail to compose your message.
  - **Version 5.0:** Use the feature to add the video thumbnail you saved. Paste in the Microsoft Stream link, give the video thumbnail a name, then Save.
  - **Version 4.9x:** Use to add the video thumbnail you saved. Now right-click on the thumbnail, choose Link, and paste in the Microsoft Stream link in the dialog window.

Now your thumbnail is a measurable link. After sending the message with PoliteMail, click on the Results tab to see how many people have clicked on the link.
