Because PoliteMail deploys dedicated servers per account, you can be assigned your own subdomain (e.g. pm.yourcompany.com or analytics.yourcompany.com) to the PoliteMail Server. This can be helpful in cases where companies have done phishing education, as the hover-over links will point to an authentic corporate domain, instead of our default hostname (yourcompany.pmail.com).
