

# Fonts changing with pasted links

If you copy and paste a link from SharePoint into a message that you are composing in PoliteMail for the Outlook Desktop, Outlook will automatically replace the font of your link with your default font used in Microsoft Office (usually Aptos).

As a workaround, you can either select the link and manually change the font, or create the link in the PoliteMail Builder and insert the link from there.

Links from Sharepoint pasted into PoliteMail for M365 or PoliteMail Online do not have this issue, nor do links from another source.
