

System Admins can go under **Settings > Server > Beefree Editor** to set some defaults for users using Beefree:

- The Allowed Languages dropdown lets SysAdmins select up to 20 languages from the list for users to select from if they want to use the Multi-Language feature, allowing recipients to view the message in their default language.
- The Beefree Content Defaults section allows a SysAdmin to enter JSON objects that will define the default look of Content objects when dragged onto the Message. For example, the JSON might define the default size, color, and padding of a button, or the formatting of a Title block.

Note that you need to know some JSON to take advantage of Content Defaults. This help article from Beefree covers the feature in greater detail.
